

To fix the rate of taxation, and to levy a tax, to defray the expense of town government and for all general town purposes, for the year 1964, on all taxable property within the corporate limits and boundaries of the town of Elizabeth.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Elizabeth that:


Section 1. The rate of taxation to defray the expenses of the town government and to meet the estimated liabilities and expenditures thereof for the year 1964, on all taxable property, real and personal, within the corporate limits and boundaries of the Town of Elizabeth is hereby fixed and levied at seven mills on the dollar of assessed valuation.


Section 2. This tax shall be due and collectible on November 15, 1964, shall become delinquent on and after December 31, 1964, and shall be collected by the Tax Collector of the Town of Elizabeth.

Section 3. Upon any tax due under the provisions of this ordinance which is not paid and delinquent thirty days after the completion of the tax bills, there shall be an interest penalty of ten per centum per annum on the amount of tax due, which shall be collected by the municipal corporation, together with and in the same manner as the tax.
