

Ordinance 07-17.2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE 07-17.1

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Elizabeth, Louisiana that Section 3 of Ordinance No. 07-17 be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Village of Elizabeth Mayor and Board of Aldermen that if provided trash container becomes lost or stolen the Village of Elizabeth will replace a minimum of (one) container per household every two years or the customer may replace such container earlier by paying the actual cost incurred by the village for such new trash container plus an administrative fee equal to 15% of such actual cost. If at any time a trash container provided to a household by the village becomes damaged beyond use the Village of Elizabeth utility system will replace the damaged container at no extra charge to its utility customers. Damaged containers must be returned to Elizabeth City Hall. The Village of Elizabeth utility system will not be held responsible for replacing trash container that are not on the leasing contract with container verification code (example: purchased containers).

THIS ORDINANCE was introduced on the 11TH day of **July, 2022** by Councilman Ken Kelly.

Notice of proposal of this Ordinance was published in the official journal on the 21st of July 2022.

Public hearing held the 8th day of August, 2022.
